The Process

External peers and thought leaders were consulted for their perspective on CPC's role in the field and its unique strengths as an organization. Through a combination of retreats, workshops, interviews, and feedback sessions, the process ensured that those closest to the work had meaningful input and ownership of the plan, fostering alignment, buy-in, and shared commitment to the organization's long-term goals.

The Need



1965

The Chinatown Planning Council was founded in Manhattan's Chinatown to remove barriers and foster opportunities for future generations.



1979

As both an organization and a community, we expanded to Flushing, Queens, and Sunset Park, Brooklyn.



1988

The Chinatown Planning Council changed its name to the Chinese-American Planning Council. From recent immigrants to older adults, CPC empowers the experiences of all community members that call New York City their home.



1998

Adult English literacy classes significantly expanded, and services for families with special needs and people living with HIV/AIDS were established.



2001

After 9/11, and two decades later, with the twin pandemics of COVID-19 and anti-Asian hate in 2020, we were on the frontlines providing essential, life-saving support, services, and recovery.



2024

CPC opened its first permanent Manhattan location. Named CPC One, this building is a historic milestone in our story, celebrating the legacies that have made impossible dreams a reality.

Position CPC as a go-to policy and program partner on community-driven solutions.


