API AIDS AWARENESS DAY LET'S TALK STIGMA

Join us CPC for our workshop on May 18 in celebration of National API HIV/AIDS Awareness Day. There, we will be opening a discussion about stigma in the API community surrounding HIV/AIDS.

- The number of Asians receiving an HIV diagnosis increased by 36%* between 2010-2014.
- Around 1 in 5* Asians living with HIV in the US don't know they have it.
- Sex is still a taboo subject in many API households, and being an HIV positive individual often carries a lot of shame and stigma.

National API HIV/AIDS Awareness Day aims to prevent HIV and end the stigma surrounding HIV through education. It's time to break the silence of HIV/AIDS in the API community and encourage people to get tested.
